Allseas to build a single-lift vessel larger than *Pieter Schelte*

Swiss-based Allseas has decided to build a second single-lift platform installation and decommissioning vessel.

The new vessel, larger than *Pieter Schelte*, can remove all platform topsides in the North Sea which are beyond the capability of *Pieter Schelte*.

Besides decommissioning, the vessel is designed for worldwide installation of very large topsides.

The topsides lift capacity will be 72,000 metric tons, exceeding the capacity of Allseas' *Pieter Schelte* by 50%.

The vessel will have a width of 160 m (525 ft), whereas *Pieter Schelte* is 124 m (406 ft) wide.

She will be operational in 2020.
